# OneCare frequently used CPT II codes for HEDIS measures (Session#1)

Listed below are frequently used HEDIS Star measures and their applicable CPT II codes.

## 1- Care for Older Adults (COA)

- a. Functional Status Assessment (FSA) Functional status assessed: use code 1170F
- Medication Review (MDR) Medication list documented in the medical record: use code 1159F
- c. Review of medications by prescribing practitioner or clinical pharmacist documented in the medical record; use code 1160F
- d. Pain Screening (PNS) Pain severity quantified, pain present: use code 1125F
- e. Pain severity quantified; no pain present: use code 1126F

# 2- Glycemic Status Assessment (GSD)

- a. Most recent HbA1c level less than 7.0%: 3044F Most recent HbA1c level above 9.0%: 3046F
- b. Most recent HbA1c level above 7.0% and less than 8.0%: 3051F
- c. Most recent HbA1c level above 8.0% and less than 9.0%: 3052F
- 3- **Eye Exam for Patients With Diabetes (EED)** (NPI required in addition to CPT II code to close care opportunity)
  - a. Without evidence of retinopathy:
    - i. Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed: use code 2023F
    - ii. Seven standard field stereoscopic retinal photos with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed: use code 2025F
  - b. With evidence of retinopathy:
    - i. Dilated retinal eye exam with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed: use code 2022F
    - Seven standard field stereoscopic retinal photos with interpretation by an ophthalmologist or optometrist documented and reviewed: use code2024F

#### 4- Controlling Blood Pressure (CBP)

- a. Systolic
  - i. Systolic less than 130: use code 3074F
  - ii. Systolic between 130 and 139: use code 3075F
  - iii. Systolic equal or above 140: use code 3077F
- b. Diastolic
  - i. Diastolic less than 80: use code 3078F
  - ii. Diastolic between 80 and 89: use code 3079F
  - iii. Diastolic equal or above 90: use code 3080F

## 5- Medication Reconciliation Post- Discharge (MRP)

a. Discharge medications reconciled with current medication list in the outpatient medical record: use code 1111F (NPI required in addition to CPT II code to close care opportunity)
